



Overview

Family owned farm for 115 years with oldest jersey herd in NZ.

Objectives

Expansion of farm by buying neighbours made the existing 50-year-old herringbone dairy too in efficient.

We wanted to improve capacity, productivity, animal health and reduce the labour required for the milking process.

The milking time of the old dairy (cups on to washed up) was approx. $4.5\,\mathrm{hours}$ with $2\,\mathrm{staff}$.

Challenges

Build price was important, meeting project needs within the available budget.

The Rotary design needed to incorporate accommodation for a young family.

Client wanted their input to the design to be valued – a collaborative approach.

Improve well-being / happiness of the herd.

Solution

DCW worked closely with the Shaws to design and build a 50 Rotary Cow Shed that could accommodate a young family and fall within their budget.

The new build has improved milking efficiency:

 1 hour 50 min with 1 person milking and 2 people during clean up to keep the shed looking like it hasn't been milked in.
